Resolution No. 6-S-2024

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2024 ANNUAL BARANGAY YOUTH INVESTMENT PROGRAM (ABYIP) OF BARANGAY MATANDANG BALARA, DISTRICT III, QUEZON CITY AMOUNTING OF EIGHT MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND THREE PESOS AND FORTY-SIX CENTAVOS ONLY (P8,554,003.46) AND APPROPRIATING EIGHT MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND THREE PESOS AND FORTY-SIX CENTAVOS ONLY (P8,554,003.46)

WHEREAS, Article 2, Section 12 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that "the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth, patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, the amended Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 11768, amending Republic Act No. 10742 also known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, provides in Section 8, Paragraph A, states that, in consultation and with the concurrence of the Katipunan ng Kabataan, and within three (3) months from assumption to office, formulate a three (3)-year rolling plan, which shall be known as the Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan, which shall serve as basis in the preparation of the Annual Barangay Youth Investment Program. This plan shall be aligned with the Philippine Youth Development Plan (PYDP) and its Local Youth Development Plans in every level, municipal, city, and provincial as is relevant;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10742, also known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, provides in Section 20, Paragraph C, states that all Sangguniang Kabataan funds shall be allocated in an annual budget, and if the funds allow, in a supplemental budget in accordance with the adopted Annual Barangay Investment Program. Both the Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan and Annual Barangay Investment Program shall give priority to programs, projects, and activities that will promote and ensure the equitable access to quality education, environmental protection, climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction and resilience, youth employment and livelihood, health and anti-drug abuse, gender sensitivity, sports development, and capability building which emphasizes leadership training;

WHEREAS, Chapter II, Section 20, Paragraph A of Republic Act No. 10742, also known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, states that Ten Percent (10%) of the general fund of the Barangay shall set aside for the Sangguniang Kabataan. The Sangguniang Kabataan shall



appropriate the SK funds in lump-sum which shall be disbursed solely for youth development and empowerment purposes;

WHEREAS, the total approved annual budget of Barangay Matandang Balara for Fiscal Year 2024 amounts to Eighty Five Million Five Hundred Forty Thousand Thirty-Four Pesos and 61/100 only (PHP 85,540,034.61);

WHEREAS, THEREFORE, that the total budget of the Sangguniang Kabataan of Matandang Balara shall be, Eight Million Five Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Three Pesos and 61/00 Centavos only (P8,554,003.46);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Kabataan of Barangay Matandang Balara has prepared the 2024 Annual Barangay Youth Investment Program, in accordance with the approved Amended Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan for Fiscal Year 2024 to 2025;

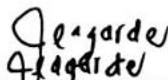
